2023 Chasity D. Barnes Scholarship Application Guidelines

Chasity D. Barnes had a passion for God and a love for people. In her short, 27 years on earth she accomplished things that older adults are still trying to do: Be a devoted and bold follower of Jesus Christ, obtain an MBA degree and be a professional in her field.

Chasity received her Bachelor's degree in Public Relations and Journalism from Troy State University in 2002 and her Masters degree in Business Administration from Troy University Dothan in 2007.

She was employed with Southeast Alabama Medical Center in the Marketing Department and later with the Medical Center Barbour in Eufaula as Marketing Director. At the time of her death she was employed with Troy University in Troy as a Community College Relations Coordinator. She was also a member of the E.L.E.T.E. Professionals Women's Club.



Education was extremely important to Chasity. She understood that without it, greater opportunities would be limited. That is why she always tried to encourage other young people to pursue their dreams of higher education.

Eligibility requirements are:

1. The Applicant must be a current high school senior and have exceptional leadership skills, academic achievement and strength of character. Preference is given to students living in the Wiregrass area.
2. All scholarship applications must be **RECEIVED by March 24, 2023** by Chasity's Champions, 103 North Memorial Drive #173, Prattville, AL 36067. Please allow ample time for delivery.
3. Applicant must be planning to pursue a degree at an accredited U.S. post-secondary institution.
4. Applicant must complete the Scholarship Application and a 250 word essay. The essay must be typed and double-spaced. The essay should explain why believe you should be selected for a scholarship. Please include a brief statement about your leadership skills, academic achievement and strength of character in the essay.
5. All applicants entering college, trade, or technical school must expect to receive a Diploma or General Education Development (GED) Certificate by June 30, 2023.
6. Funds are to be utilized by December 31, 2023. Funds may be used at accredited universities and colleges, community colleges, and trade/technical schools.
7. Each application from a current high school senior applicant must contain the following support documentation:
 - Proof of academic performance (transcript)
 - Proof of ACT score
 - Letter of recommendation from an academic professional
 - Letter of recommendation from a community leader or peer
 - Resume that includes community service, clubs, any other pertinent information

Chasity's Champions provides a one-time \$1,000 scholarship to serious students only.
